Definition of Isosceles Triangle : An isosceles triangle is a triangle that has at least two sides of equal length. Because those sides are equal, the angles opposite them are also equal.

The main properties of an isosceles triangle:

- a) Two sides are equal in length.
- b) Angles opposite the equal sides are equal (called base angles)
- c) The third side is called the base
- d) The angle between the two equal sides is called the vertex angle.
- e) A line drawn from the vertex angle to the base:
 - Bisects the base (cuts it into two equal parts)
 - Bisects the vertex angle
 - Is perpendicular to the base
- f) The triangle has one line of symmetry, passing through the vertex angle and the midpoint of the base.

2. The vertex angle of an isosceles triangle is 40° . Find each base angle.

3. The perimeter of an isosceles triangle is 36 cm. If each equal side is 14 cm, find the base.
