Geography-

Q1. Explain how the physiographic divisions of India influence climate, vegetation, and human activities.

Answer:

- The Himalayas act as a barrier, preventing cold winds from Central Asia and causing monsoon rains in India.
- The Northern Plains support intensive agriculture due to fertile alluvial soil.
- The Peninsular Plateau is rich in minerals, promoting mining and industries.
- The Coastal Plains support fishing, trade, and plantation crops.
- The Islands provide strategic defense locations and biodiversity.

Q2. Discuss the role of rivers in shaping the economy and culture of India.

Answer:

- Rivers provide fertile soil through alluvial deposits, supporting agriculture.
- Hydropower generation helps in industrial and domestic use.
- Rivers act as transport routes (e.g., Ganga, Brahmaputra).
- They hold cultural and religious significance (e.g., Ganga in Hindu rituals).
- Provide freshwater for drinking, irrigation, and industries.

Q3. The Himalayas are geologically young and structurally unstable. Examine the statement with examples.

Answer:

- Himalayas were formed due to the collision of Indo-Australian and Eurasian plates ~40 million years ago (geologically young).
- They are still rising; earthquakes (Nepal 2015) show instability.
- Frequent landslides and floods (Himachal, Uttarakhand) highlight fragility.
- Glacial lake outburst floods (GLOFs) are common.
- Despite instability, they play a vital role in climate and water resources.

Q4. How does the Peninsular Plateau differ from the Northern Plains in terms of relief, resources, and economy?

Answer:

- **Relief:** Plateau – uneven, rocky, with hills and valleys; Plains – flat and extensive.
- **Resources:** Plateau – mineral rich (coal, iron ore, manganese); Plains – fertile alluvial soil.
- **Economy:** Plateau – supports mining and industries; Plains – agriculture-based with high population density.
- **Drainage:** Plateau rivers – seasonal and fast-flowing; Plains rivers – perennial and navigable.
- **Human Settlement:** Plateau – scattered; Plains – dense.

Q5. Evaluate the importance of coastal plains and islands in India's strategic and economic development.

Answer:

- Coastal plains provide fertile land for rice, coconut, and spices cultivation.
- Fishing and aquaculture are major livelihood sources.
- Ports (Mumbai, Chennai, Kochi) enhance trade and commerce.
- Islands (Andaman & Nicobar, Lakshadweep) provide defence outposts and EEZ (Exclusive Economic Zone).
- Tourism (Goa, Andaman's, Kerala backwaters) contributes to economy.
